The health check period from April 5th to April 19th is to ensure all students and faculty's safety. At the same time, it's needed measures not to expand coronavirus (COVID-19) to Akita prefecture. During the two weeks of health check period, please stay home, reduce exposure to crows and avoid direct communication and contact to quarantine yourself.
